





# County Road 5 bridge project nearing completion

Crews are finishing work on the County Road 5 bridge over the North Fork Crow River near Albright Mills County Park in Middleville Township, according to Erickson Engineering, KRWC radio reported.

Final steps include paving, guardrails, striping, and slope seeding. The project began in late February and is expected to finish by July 20. Rain caused delays but did not alter the schedule.

Meanwhile, work has started on replacing the County Road 8 bridge over the Crow River in Marysville Township, with completion expected by late fall.

# Corcoran couple injured in crash

A Corcoran couple was injured in Itasca County Tuesday afternoon when their pickup left the road and hit a tree after the driver suffered a medical emergency, KRWC radio reported.

The State Patrol said William McGarry, 67, lost consciousness while driving north on Highway 46 around 12:45 p.m. on July 1.

Both he and passenger Jean McGarry, 69, sustained non-life threatening injuries and were treated at Essentia Deer River Hospital. The Itasca County Sheriff's Office, Northome Fire Department, and Essentia Deer River Ambulance responded.

Four Gibbon residents - Mitch and Dana Lietzau, Jayson Berskow, and Andrea Wortz — have purchased D's Pit Stop from Denise Rieke and will reopen it as The Local on Monday, July 7, Winthrop News reported.

The new owners took possession July 1 and are using the first week of the month for cosmetic updates, including painting and new flooring. The group had discussed buying the bar for years before finalizing the purchase earlier this year.

# Orono dedicates \$300,000 to sewer rehab

Orono is spending \$300,000 on sewer rehabilitation to reduce inflow and infiltration of clean water into its sewer system, the Laker Pioneer reported.

Rogers-based Hydro-Klean will perform manhole and spot lining at various sites, including Kelley Parkway, North Arm Drive, and Leaf Street. The city plans to invest \$300,000 annually in similar projects through 2033.

Excessive inflow has led to warnings from the Metropolitan Council. Officials say up to 80% of the issue stems from private sources and urge property owners to inspect and repair sewer lines.

# **Buffalo imposes slow-no** wake zones on two lakes

The Buffalo City Council on June 30 enacted emergency slowno wake zones on Buffalo Lake and Lake Pulaski due to high water levels and shoreline erosion caused by recent heavy rains, KRWC radio reported.

All motorized watercraft must travel no more than 5 mph within 600 feet of shore. The restriction will remain in place for 30 days unless lifted or extended by the council with DNR approval. The Wright County Sheriff's Office will enforce the rule.

### aebut season

VOCE Community Choir, a new adult choral group directed by Kelly Newell, recently concluded its first season with concerts at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Wayzata, the Laker Pioneer reported.

The Westonka-based choir began in November with 40 singers and performed a range of music tied to the theme "We Are." VOCE rehearses at Westonka High School and offers two 10week sessions annually.

The next session starts Sept. 2, with concerts set for Nov. 1 and 2. Registration opens in August at westonkace.org.

# Waconia complex named for late community leader

Developers have named a new 92-unit apartment and retail complex in Waconia "The Wilford," honoring longtime businessman and community leader Wilfred "Will" Yetzer, who died in 2016, the Sun Patriot reported.

The building, located on Second Street between Elm and Olive, broke ground in February and is expected to open next spring. Construction has reached grade level, and framing is set to begin around July 4.

The site includes underground parking and public surface spaces. City infrastructure work in the area is ongoing, with stage 3 set to begin in early July.

# Multiple tornadoes confirmed in Carver County

The National Weather Service confirmed two EF1 tornadoes touched down early Sunday in Carver County, KRWC radio reported.

One tornado tracked from Goose Lake to Lake Waconia, and another from Stone Lake through Zumbra Lake to Lake Minnewashta. Additional EF0 tornadoes also occurred, with final assessments pending.

Carver County officials are working working to restore power and manage debris following the June 29 storms. Officials urge residents to avoid downed power lines, use caution around storm debris, and document property damage for insurance claims.
