





Five injured in two-vehicle crash near Becker

Five people were injured Monday, June 23, when a Jeep and a Nissan collided at the intersection of State Highway 25 and 97th Street Southeast in Becker Township bear Becker, according to the State Patrol, KRWC radio reported.

A 16-year-old Eden Prairie girl driving the Jeep and her two 16-year-old passengers were treated for non-life-threatening injuries at St. Cloud Hospital.

The Nissan's driver, 92-year-old Phillip Terrill, and his passenger, 77-year-old Pamela Terrill, both of Chisago City, were also treated for non-life-threatening injuries.

Big Island docks damaged during winter storage

The docks at Big Island Park, used by veterans since 2008 and 2009, were damaged during winter storage, the Laker Pioneer re-

Former Orono Mayor Gabriel Jabbour, who organizes veterans' visits, said the docks are now unsafe. The city contracted Tonka Built for dock removal and storage; the company said the docks were previously damaged. A last-minute change forced the city to crane the docks onto shore.

Jabbour criticized the decision and handling. City officials acknowledged the damage and are considering long-term replacement, though no funding is currently allocated.

Monticello woman injured in car-deer crash

Jennifer Banister, 50, of Monticello, was injured June 22 when her northbound Chevy Colorado struck a deer on Highway 64 in Akeley Township, Hubbard County, KRWC radio reported.

The State Patrol said the deer entered the roadway from the east ditch and was hit head-on. Banister sustained non-lifethreatening injuries and was taken to St. Joseph's Hospital in Park Rapids.

The Hubbard County Sheriff's Office and North Ambulance assisted at the scene.

Ridgeview ranks high for patient experience

Ridgeview has been named a 2025 Outstanding Patient Experience Award recipient by Healthgrades, placing it among the top 5 percent of hospitals nationwide for the fifth consecutive year, the Laker Pioneer reported.

It is one of only six hospitals in Minnesota to receive the honor this year. Ridgeview has earned the award for 17 straight years, ranking in the top 15 percent nationally since 2009.

Healthgrades evaluated more than 3,000 hospitals using patient survey data from January to December 2023.

Lobbyist charged with making violent threats

Jonathan Michael Bohn of Woodbury, a lobbyist at the Minnesota State Capitol, was charged June 20 in Carver County with felony threats of violence, the Sun Patriot reported.

The complaint alleges Bohn sent threatening text messages to an acquaintance at a Waconia restaurant on June 18, including comments about buying 500 bullets and threatening gun violence at the Capitol.

Bail was set at \$100,000 cash or \$1 million bond with conditions including no firearms, no Capitol access, and no contact with the victim. His next court appearance is Aug. 27.

Emerald ash borer confirmed in five more counties

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture has confirmed emerald ash borer infestations in Meeker, Murray, Otter Tail, and Wadena counties, and a previously uninfested part of Carlton County. This brings the statewide total to 58 counties.

Emergency quarantines have been enacted for the newly affected areas to limit the movement of ash materials and firewood. The agency will hold a virtual informational meeting July 8 and is accepting public comments on the quarantine language through August 8, with formal adoption scheduled for August 11.
